
No Firearms Policy

Keweenaw Unitarian Universalist Fellowship

Effective Date: October 1, 2024

As part of our commitment to fostering a safe, inclusive, and peaceful environment, KUUF has adopted the following policy regarding firearms:

1. **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that our premises remain a safe and welcoming place for fellowship, reflection, and community activities. To this end, we strictly prohibit the carrying, possession, or use of firearms on fellowship property.

2. **Scope**

This policy applies to all individuals, including but not limited to members, visitors, staff, volunteers, and contractors, except for authorized law enforcement personnel acting in their official capacity.

3. **Policy Statement**

For the safety and security of everyone in our community, the open or concealed possession or carrying of firearms, with or without permits, is strictly prohibited on the premises of Keweenaw Unitarian Universalist Fellowship.

This policy applies during all events, worship services, and activities held on fellowship property, regardless of whether the event is hosted by the fellowship or an external group.

4. **Notification and Signage**

Clear signage will be posted at all building entrances. Additionally, this policy will be included on our website, to help ensure that all members and visitors are aware.
